


THE WINDMILLS

In La Mancha (Al-Ansha: dry land or land without water), there were not rivers to get energy from and cereal was practically the only farming. For those reasons the power of wind was sourced to grind wheat into flour.

The working is simple though interesting. Once the dome is positioned and the arms are placed facing the wind, they are covered with cloth or canvas. The sails move the axel which in turn, through its gear mechanism, moves two grinding stones to mill wheat into flour.

It is worth mentioning that now a days twelve windmills have been recovered, from the original thirteen once found in the hill.

Spain Square

1.1 Town Hall. It was built in 1670, with walls made of rows of double course of bricks boxing a stone and mortar core. The most interesting parts are the clock tower and arch, which are later additions to the building.

1.2 School San Gumersindo. Historicist building in the Castilian-Mudejar style. It was built in the beginning of the 20 century.

1.3 Corredores. Built in the 17 century. It is one of the outstanding buildings in the city. It has a wooden balcony to the whole of the first floor. It contains the Municipal Museum with archaeological artefacts from the neolithic to the end of the 19 century.

2.1 Church of Saint Mary the Great. Built in 1723 it is formed of a single nave in the Castilian-Mudejar style.



2.2 Mothers of the Inmaculate Conception. The building presents the singularity of the mixture of Gothic and Mudeiar styles creating a differentiated and harmonic group.



Square of Saint John

5.1 Church of Saint John the Baptist. It was built in 1567 in the renaissance style with latin cross plant and longitudinal structure. The façade is copesed in the traditional Castilian-Mudejar style with a tower to the left divided in four symmetrical parts.

5.2 Coat of arm of the surname Cervantes. The stone coat of arms is located in the sidewall of the house in 11, low Vertedera street. It depicts two deer. The existence since the 16 century of this

family name in Consuegra is well documented.



Saint John's Order old headquarters in the town. It was built over the remains of the Roman thermal baths. It was constituted of three distinctive areas, the Church, of which the apse is still in place, the Prior`s residence and the tower.

Convent of the Carmelites

It was founded in 1597 in accordance to Don Fernando Alvarez de Toledo`s Will. It presents a single nave and big buttresses in the traditional Carmelite Construction



Monastery of the Franciscan

Founded in the 17 century, it has suffered important transformations after several donations. The building presents the traditional convent construction and it consists of two cloisters and a church.





The Pottery

It is a building of popular typology built over the remains of the Roman circus. It was in used for traditional pottery until the mid 70s. In Its interior there are two ancient Kilns and some Roman remains.



Church of Saint Rafael

Located in the popular neighbourhood of the -Imparcial-in the Gothic-Mudejar style. Its construction completed the reconstruction of the city after floods occurred on 11 september 1891.



Old town houses

Embellishing the city, these large buildings typically combined labour functions and main residence, in the tradition of La Mancha. Of particular interest are the iron works in balconies and windows.



Roman dam

Located 4 Km away from the city, near the road to Urda, it has a length of 638 meters, making it the longest Roman dam that remains in the whole of the empire. Its central area is reinforced with 14 buttresses and contains an opening for the regulated water to run to the river.



10 Calderico Hill

10.1 Windmills.

Next to the castle, they conform the unique silhouette of the mount Calderico. There are 12 mills remaining out of the original 13. Of these, the "Sancho", "Bolero", "Espartero" and "Rucio" retain the complete machinery.

10.2 Castle.

Its origin goes back to the caliphate of Cordoba. King Alfonso VIII gave it to the order of Saint John of Jerusalem in 1183, becoming their headquarters in Castile and Leon. In the year 1813 the castle was ruined by the Napoleonic troops. At present, parts of the fortress have been restored allowing the visit of several naves, aliibes (reserves of water), the east, west and south towers, the archive nave, the meeting room or the chapel.
